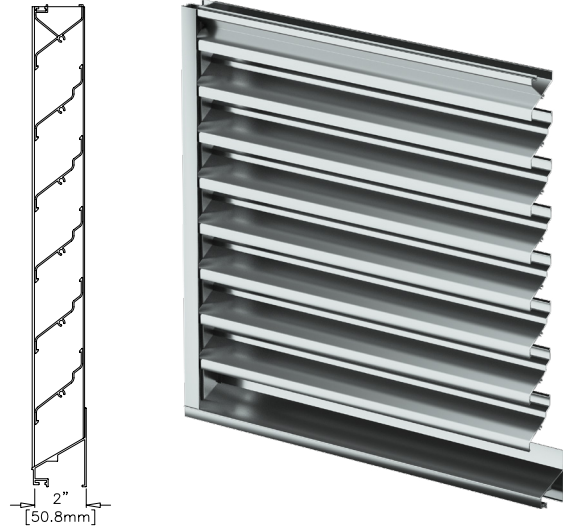

<b>Blades</b>	Non-drainable design, heavy gauge extruded 6063-T5 aluminum, 0.063 in. (2 mm) nominal wall thickness, positioned 45° on approximately 3 in. (76 mm) centers
<b>Louver Depth</b>	2 in. (51 mm)

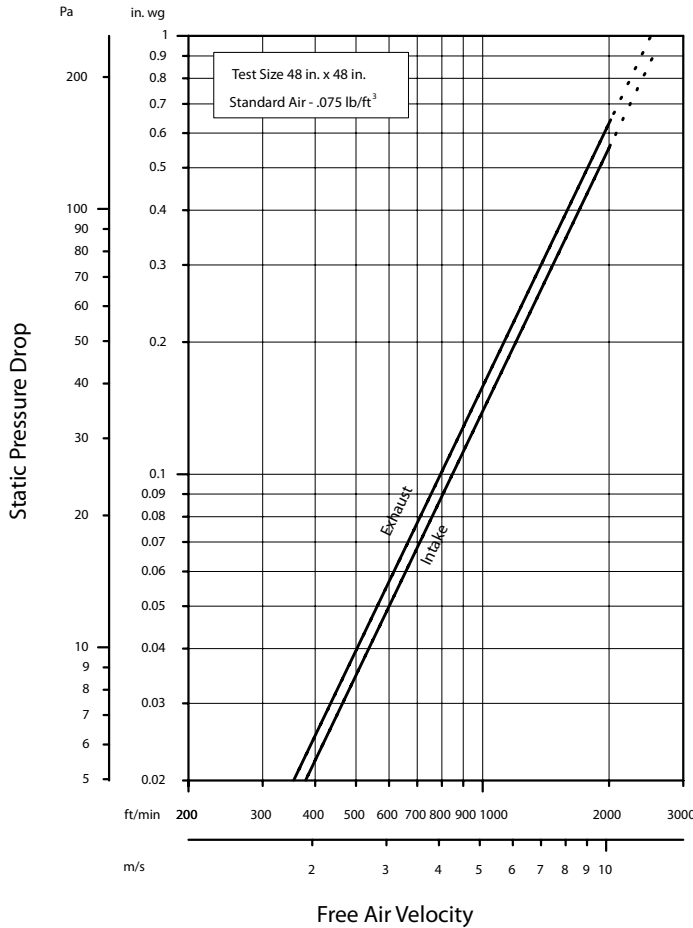

## Airflow Resistance

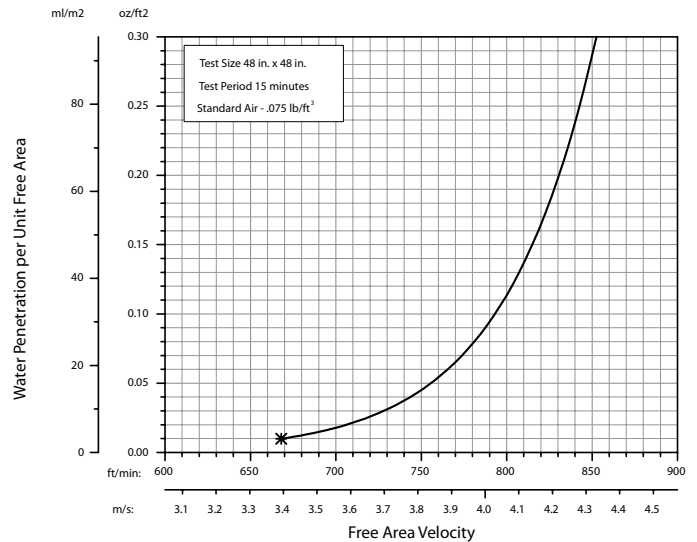
Model T6482 resistance to airflow (pressure drop) varies depending on louver application (air intake or air exhaust). Free area velocities (shown) are higher than average velocity through the overall louver size. See louver selection information. (Test Figure 5.5-6.5)

## Water Penetration

Test duration of 15 min.



The AMCA Water Penetration Test provides a method for comparing various louver models and designs as to their efficiency in resisting the penetration of rainfall under specific laboratory test conditions. The beginning point of water penetration is defined as that velocity where the water penetration curve projects through 0.01 oz. (3 g) of water (penetration) per sq. ft. (m<sup>2</sup>) of louver free area. \*The beginning point of water penetration for Model T6482 is 668 fpm (5.116 m/s) free area velocity. These performance ratings do not guarantee a louver to be weatherproof or stormproof and should be used in combination with other factors including good engineering judgement in selecting louvers.
